Art work, entry form and fee must be received by: Saturday 10/31/09. Late entries will be accepted on a space available basis only. All art works must be delivered to the UCONN Stamford Art Gallery on Saturday, October 31st between 11 and 3 pm. Each piece must have an identification tag affixed to the back. Notification of Non-acceptance in show by: Wednesday, November 3rd. Announcement of winners by: November 6th.

Exhibit Dates: November 6th through December 29th, 2009 (Art pieces must stay on display for the entire show).

Fine Art Photos in black & white or color may be submitted in any of **six** categories:

- PEOPLE AND PORTRAITS
- LANDSCAPES
- PETS AND ANIMALS
- PICTURES THAT TELL A STORY
- DIGITALLY ENHANCED OR COMPUTER GENERATED PHOTOGRAPHY
- YEAR OF SCIENCE THEME*: artistic impressions of science (special category, see note below.)

Whenever categories are in question, the juror's final decision of category designation will stand.

Entry Fees: \$15.00 for one piece, \$25.00 for 2 pieces, \$5.00 for additional pieces up to a maximum of 4 entries.

Entry fees are non-refundable. Entry into this show shall be taken as agreement to all conditions outlined in this prospectus. No more than 4 entries may be submitted to the jurors. This is a blind, juried show; accordingly, the entrant's name should not be plainly visible on the work itself. Whenever categories are in question, the juror's final decision of category designation will be binding. No work may exceed 78" H x 32" W or 100 lbs. All entries **must** be framed and ready to hang with wire. Photography submitted unframed, improperly framed, or without wire will be disqualified. Payment of entry fees does not insure acceptance of any or all works submitted, nor are refunds available for unsuitable works once submitted.

Prizes and Awards:*

- Prizes:
- 5 - \$75.00 for First prize per category
 - 5 - \$50.00 for Second prize per category
 - 5 - Honorable Mention ribbon for each category
 - 1 - \$75.00 for one People's Choice Award
 - 1 - \$100.00 for one Best in Show Award
 - See below for Year of Science Award

Ribbons will be awarded for first, second, and honorable mention in all categories. The decision of the jurors is final.

Cash prizes will be awarded for first and for second place in each of five categories. *The Year of Science category will offer \$100 for first place, \$50 for second, and \$25 for third. The Year of Science prizes will be awarded to works that clearly endeavor to celebrate science, nature, and/or the environment, and/or that represent the study of science.

Artist Reception: An artist reception will be held on Saturday, November 14th, from 1-3 PM or as otherwise arranged and announced. Artists and their friends and family members are invited to attend the Opening Reception. Prizes and awards will be announced at this time except for People's Choice Award. Ballots for People's Choice award will be available for voting from first day of show through the end of November. Winner will be announced in early December.

Sale of Art: Entries may be listed for sale during the exhibit if so desired by the artist. By entering, the artist agrees to make a tax-deductible donation payable to the University of Connecticut Stamford Art Gallery. This donation will be no less than 30% of selling price of any/all work sold. All entries must remain in the gallery for the duration of the show.

Reproduction and representation: In submitting works, the creator agrees that the University of Connecticut may reproduce or represent works on its website, in publications, and in publicity for future art exhibitions and related events. The University agrees to credit the creator as possible and appropriate within such reproductions.

Preparation of Accepted Work: Entries will be handled with the utmost care. All entries should be ready for hanging, with screw, eyes and wire, and prepared for handling and exhibition. Works inadequately prepared will be disqualified and the University will not be responsible for any damage or loss incurred. Participation indicates that the entrant understands and accepts this clause and conditions as stated.

Liability, Insurance, and Retrieval of Works: The University of Connecticut at Stamford Art Gallery will insure all accepted work for the value of artist's stated verifiable value retail price. If other arrangements are not made 10 days in advance, any work not picked up by December 29th by 2 pm is no longer insured by UConn. If artwork is not picked up on time, artist agrees to pay a \$50.00 administrative charge. In addition, any works not removed after 30 days become the property of the University of Connecticut.
