3. Have the application signed by a Women's Studies Faculty Advisor. (See list below.)
4. Send the signed Application for the WS Minor to the Registrar's Office at Storrs together with the final plan of study for your Major. This form is normally filed by the fourth week of the semester before you graduate. See your advisor or the Registrar early in the semester for official filing deadline dates.
5. Turn in a photocopy of both the form and an unofficial transcript to Ingrid Semaan, Director of Women's Studies.
